- **Education** -- High School Graduate or GED -- one (1) year of high school algebra with passing grade, or one post high school algebra course with passing grade.
- **Application Fee** -- \$50.00 Electrical Program, \$50.00 Telecommunication Program; payable upon application (fee is non-refundable – **payable by Money Order, Visa or MasterCard - No cash or personal checks accepted**).
- **Other Requirements** – Applicants must live within the area covered by Local 103, IBEW. Electrical Applicants must score “high” on aptitude test S-72R77, as administered by the Massachusetts Department of Employment and Training.
